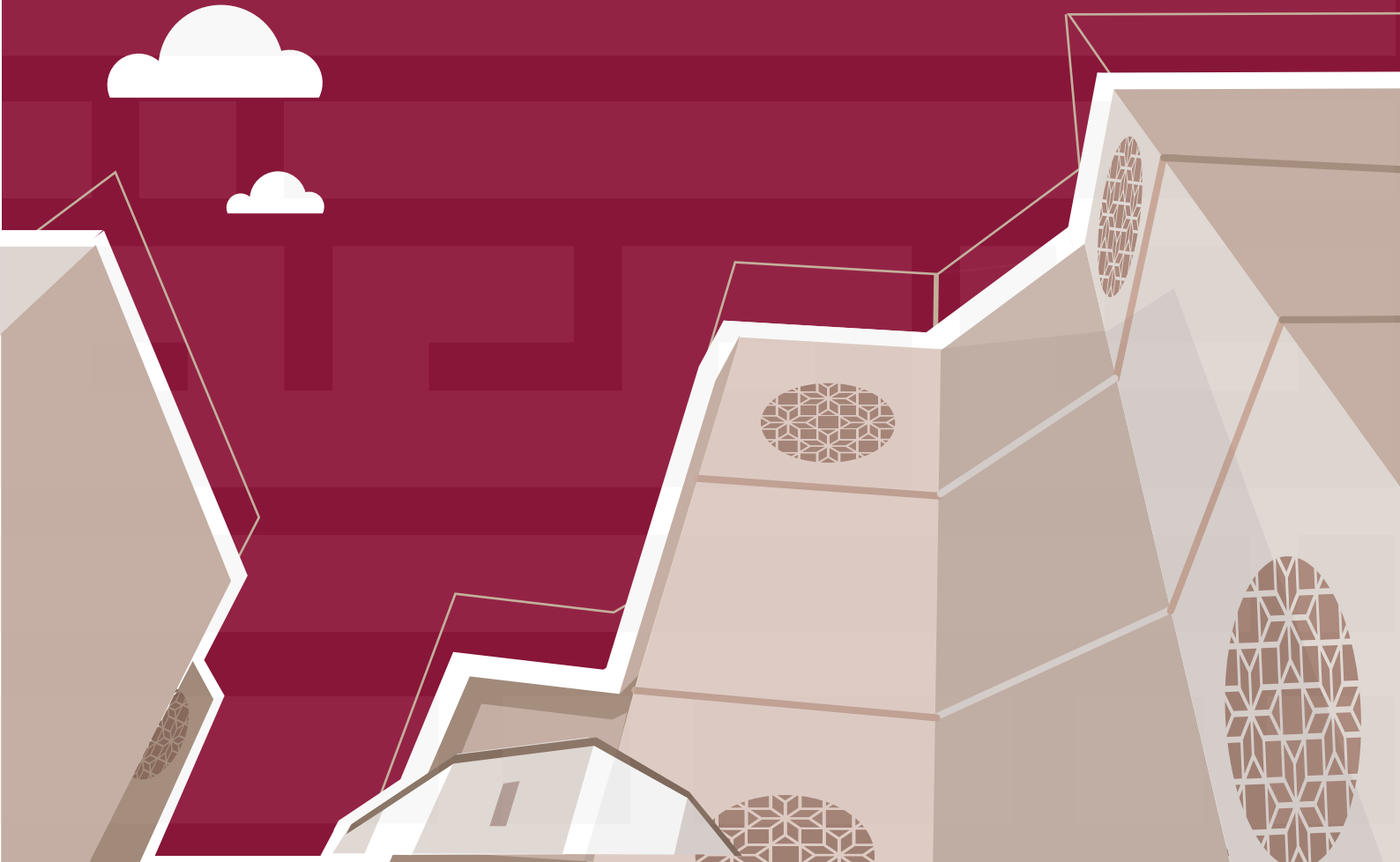

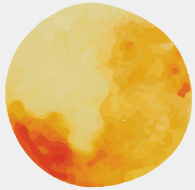

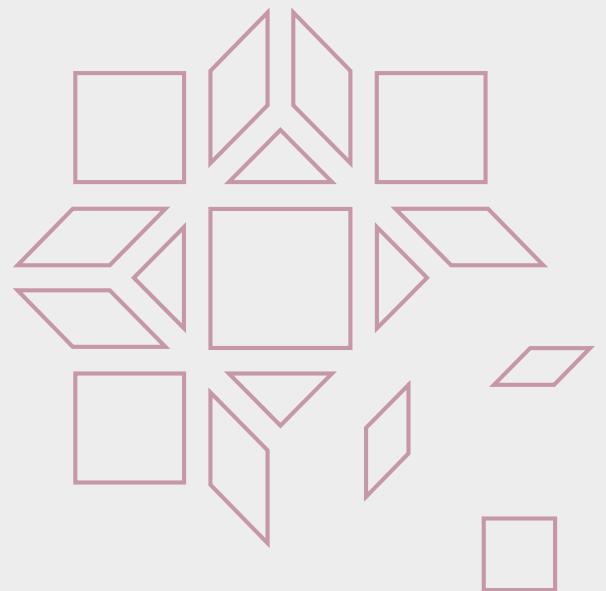

Minor

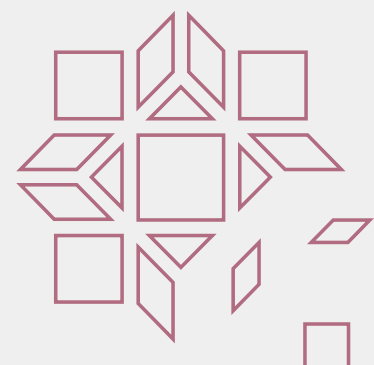
A curriculum component of an academic program intended to provide a limited depth and/or breadth study in a discipline or a professional field of study.

Placement Test

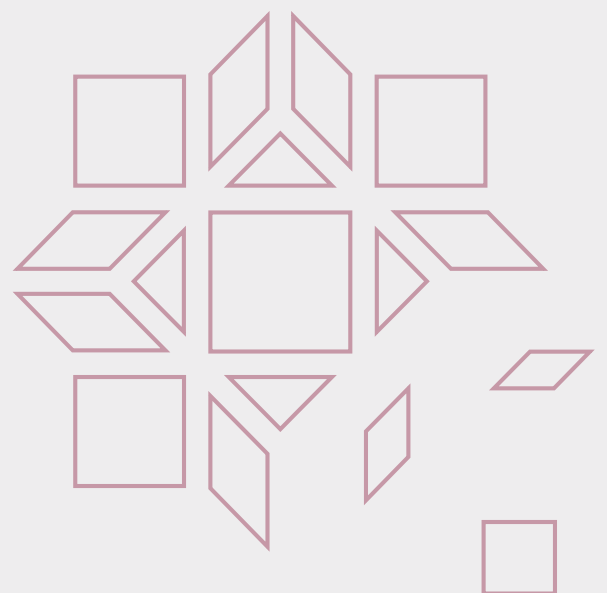
Is a proficiency exam provided to students to examine their capabilities in Math and English.

College Requirements:

- Students may declare their major after completing the GNSP 101 course.
- To declare a major, students must have successfully completed a minimum of 12 credit hours.
- For admission to the Sport Management program, students must pass a personal interview during the second semester of their enrollment in the College.
- For admission to the Sport Coaching program, students (excluding those from the Science track) must pass the admission test and the fitness test, in addition to a personal interview during the second semester of their enrollment in the College.
- Admission to major programs is competitive and subject to each program's capacity.
- A registration hold is placed on undeclared students who have completed 36 credit hours, prior to the early registration period for the following semester. These students must submit a major declaration request to have the hold removed.

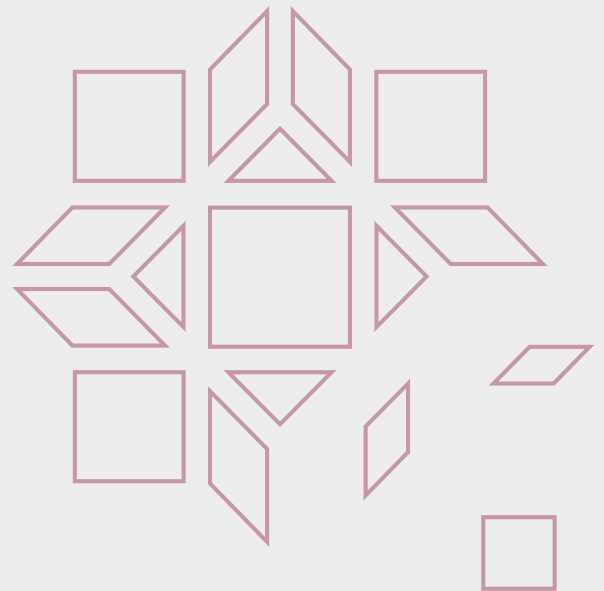

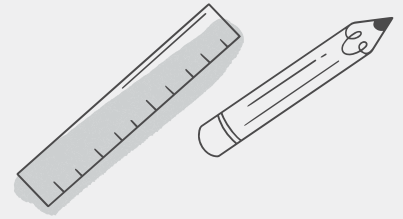


03 HIGH SCHOOL REQUIREMENTS

High School Requirements



Students that wish to apply to Qatar University must complete twelve years of formal education and their transcript result must be accredited by the Ministry of Education and Higher Education. The high school requirement mentioned in this section are only considered the minimum requirement and does not guarantee the students admission , as it depends on the students application and available capacity in the college. This said, certain colleges might acquire additional requirements that could include standardized tests result, personal statements or even recommendation letters.

General Secondary Schools

The 12th grade final high school percentage is used when considering applicants from General Secondary Schools which is minimum 70%, the High School track will be taken into considerations when applying to QU. For more information please visit [College Requirements](#).

Governmental Schools

Graduates from Independent Schools in the academic year 2009/2010 onwards are admitted according to Qatar Senior School Certificates (QSSC) on the basis of the final total result for the last year. For students who have obtained the Independent Certificate before the academic year 2009/2010, they will be admitted on the basis of the table of Score Equivalency in each Academic Year.

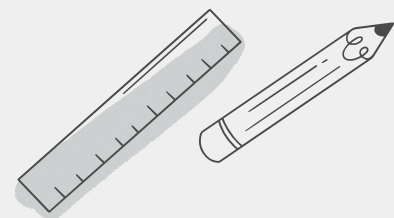
Grade Point Average (GPA) System (American School System)

- Awarded a High School Diploma in a General Studies Curriculum with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.00 on a 4.00 scale (“C”) and satisfies the minimum high school percentage requirement during the final year of high school.
- Passed at least six different subjects including at least one science (biology, physics, chemistry), one mathematics (algebra, trigonometry, geometry), and one English Language course during the Junior or Senior year.
- For Science Track certification, 2 Science subjects (Biology, Physics, Chemistry) and 1 Mathematics subject with minimum grade of 2.00 (or C equivalent) are required.

British Secondary School System IGCSE

- Applicants must have successfully completed at least five IGCSE (O Level) subjects with a minimum grade of “D” or “3”, in addition to two subjects at the Advanced (A Level), Advanced Subsidiary (AS Level), or a combination of both levels, with a minimum grade of “D” in each. The submitted subjects must include at least one subject in Mathematics, one in Science, and one in Languages. One additional AS or A Level subject with a minimum grade of “E” may also be submitted to count toward the certificate equivalency.
- As the official results for this school system will be released after QU has announced admission decisions, applicants may submit predicted grades in addition to official result certificates by the submission deadline. Applicants who submit [predicted high school grades \(pdf\)](#) will be considered for Provisional Admission.
- For the Scientific Track certification, applicants must pass one Mathematics subject and two Science subjects (Biology, Physics, or Chemistry), each with a minimum grade of “D”.

High School Requirements



International Baccalaureate (IB) System

- Completion of the full IB Diploma with at least 2 subjects at the HL and the other 4 subjects at SL level.
- The student should have attained a total grade point score of 24 out of 42, excluding grades for Theory of Knowledge (TOK) and Extended Essay.
- As the official results for this school system will be released after QU has announced admission decisions, applicants may submit predicted grades by the submission deadline. Applicants who submit predicted high school grades (pdf) will be considered for Provisional Admission.
- For Science Track certification, 2 Science courses (Biology, Physics, Chemistry) and one Mathematics course with minimum Grade of 4 (2 of these 3 subjects must be at the HL) and a minimum Grade of 3 in the other three subjects.

Other School Systems for Private and International School Certificates

- The Admissions Section will review and evaluate each certificate individually to determine the appropriate admission track.
- In case the high school transcript indicates student's track (Arts/Science), the indicated track will be considered.
- In case the high school transcript does not indicate student's track, applicant must complete at least two Science courses (Biology, Physics, Chemistry) and one Mathematics course to be eligible for Science track.

Students that wish to apply to a scientific college/ major must complete the following:

American School System (GPA):

- Students must complete two Science subjects and one Mathematics subject with minimum grade of 2.00 (or C equivalent) are required.

Students that follow the British School System:

- Students must complete 2 sciences subjects (Biology, Chemistry, Physics) and one math course with a minimum of a C or 4

Students that follow the International Baccalaureate System (IB)

- Student must score a minimum Grade of 4 in Math and two Science subjects (2 of these 3 subjects must be at the HL) and a minimum Grade of 3 in the other three subjects.

Community School Systems:

- Students that follow the Indian School System (CBSE) complete must complete a minimum of 1 Science subject & 1 Math Subject Completed to apply for a Science Major.
- Students that follow the Pakistani System must have a minimum of 2 Science subject & 1 Math Subject Completed to apply for a Science Major
- Students that follow other systems must have a minimum of 2 Science Subjects & 1 Math Subject to apply for a Science Major

- High schools graduates will be accepted based on the educational tracks starting from Fall
- High school graduates from Qatar Technical School will be accepted on colleges that accept the Scientific track.
- High school graduates from Qatar Banking Studies and Business Administration will be accepted on colleges that accept the Arts and Humanities track.
- High School Graduates from Qatar Science and Technology School will be accepted on colleges that accept scientific track
- High School track will be taken into considerations when applying to QU for Private and International School Certificates . For more information please visit High School Applicants page.



Other School Systems for Private and International School Certificates

Admission Department will review and evaluate each certificate and decide the track:

- In case the high school transcript indicates student's track (Arts/Science), the indicated track will be considered.
- In case the high school transcript does not indicate student's track, applicant must complete at least two Science courses (Biology, Physics, Chemistry) and one Mathematics course to be eligible for Science track.

High School Percentage Exception

Applicants that do not meet the minimum requirement mentioned on the previous page still do have the opportunity to apply their preferred college/ major by completing high school and meeting the minimum pre-requisite as mentioned below:

Applicants to the Colleges of Arts and Science, Business and Economics, Education, Law:

Mathematics

- A minimum score of 24 in ACT Math OR
- A minimum score of 550 in SAT (General Math Component- old version) OR
- A minimum score of 570 in SAT (General Math component- new version)

Applicants to Colleges of Engineering, Dental Medicine, Medicine, Pharmacy, Sciences and Health Sciences:

English

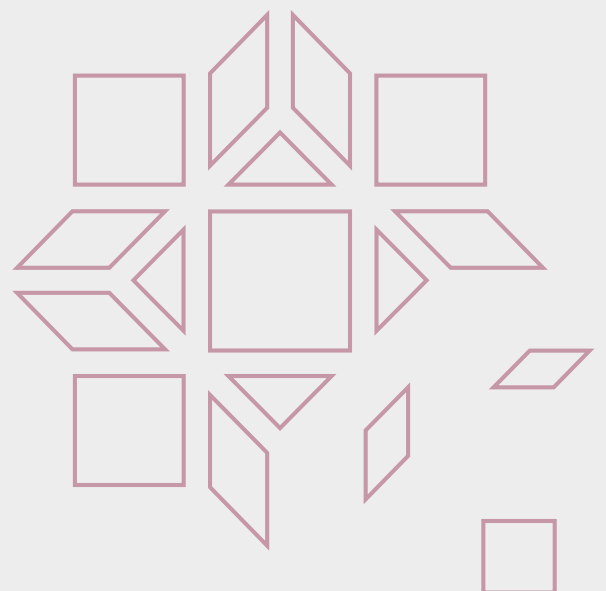
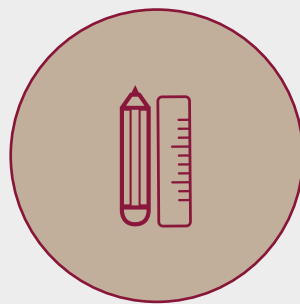
- A minimum score of 5.5 in IELTS
- A minimum score of 61 in TOEFL iBT
- A minimum score of 6 in IELTS and 68 in TOEFL iBT for Medicine and Dental Medicine

Mathematics

- A minimum score of 24 in ACT Math
- A minimum score of 550 in SAT (General Math Component- old version) OR
- A minimum score of 570 in SAT (General Math component- new version)

The Dean of college will consider such requests against the quality and depth of the applicant profile, and the available capacity within the applicant's intended major and high school performance.

04 FOUNDATION PROGRAM



Foundation Program

In order for students to be admitted to any scientific major or college, and be exempted from the foundation program, students must meet the minimum requirements and acquire basic skills of both Mathematics and English

Exemption rules from Foundation Program:

Satisfy the minimum competency scores for English and mathematics for the following colleges:

- College of Arts and Sciences (Science track only)
- College of Education (Secondary education with concentrations in mathematics and sciences only)
- College of Engineering
- College of Health Sciences
- College of Pharmacy
- College of Nursing

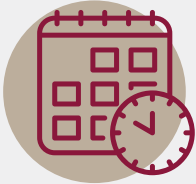

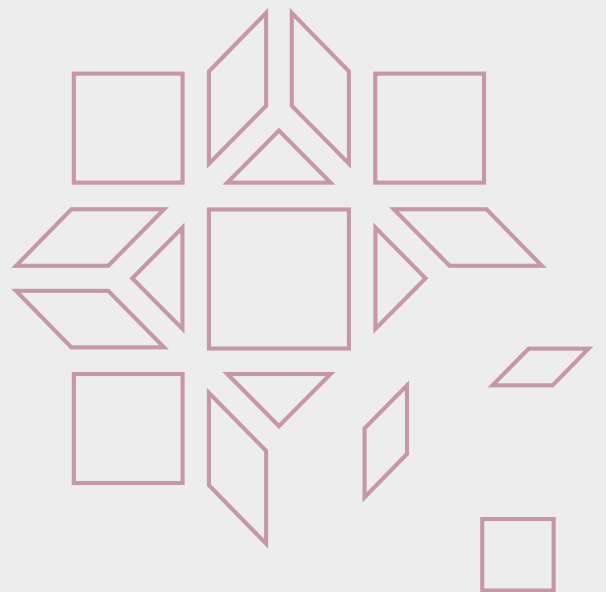
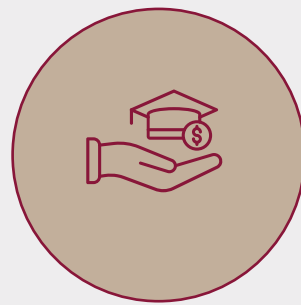

05 SCHOLARSHIP & SPONSORSHIP TYPES



Scholarship

Qatar University offers numerous scholarships to attract and support academically intellectual students. Although scholarships are granted on a competitive basis, all scholarships cover tuition fees. Some scholarships may also include one or more of the following:

- Textbooks
- Accommodation in university housing.
- Annual ticket to the home country for non-resident students in Qatar.

The applicant may apply to the admission scholarship through the online admission application in the “Scholarship Application” section during the announced application period.

The Scholarship Program Types:

Competitive Scholarships

Students are selected on competitive basis for the competitive scholarships based on their university GPA if the student is current student at QU, or based on their high school GPA if the student is a newly admitted student. Competitive Scholarships include:

Academic Scholarships

- International Students Scholarship
- HH the Emir of Qatar Scholarship for Academic Excellence
- Outstanding Performance Scholarship
- GCC States Scholarship (Embassies)

Talented Scholarships

Scholarships that are given to new students from inside and outside Qatar who are talented in the fields of science, technology and innovation literature, media, athletics, and acting for male students only.

Non-Competitive Scholarships

Students can benefit of non-competitive scholarships if they are eligible for them.

2.1. Complete Online Admission Application

All undergraduate applicants to Qatar University are required to apply to their intended college of study using the QU online admission application.

Note: The QU online admission application allows you to complete your application or save your application to complete at a later time, review and submit your admissions application from the convenience of your personal computer with in the announced deadline.



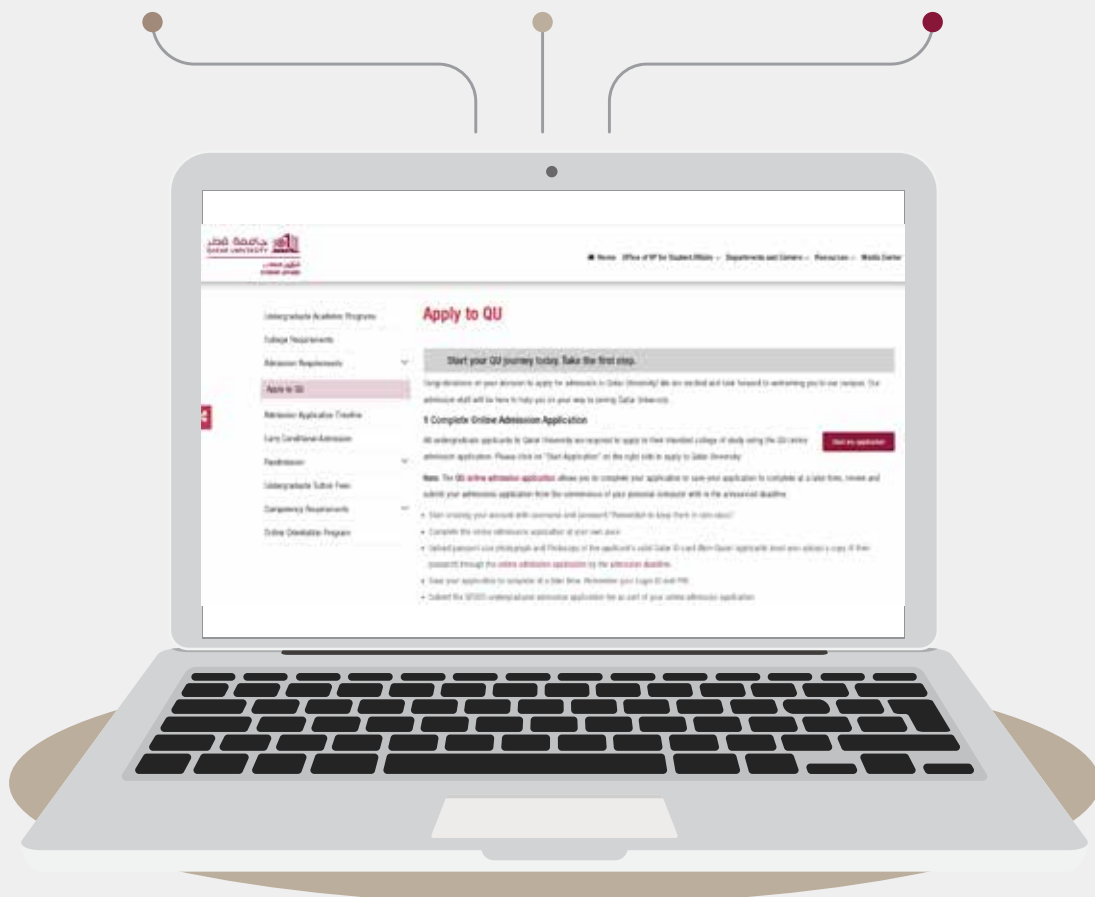

2.2. Submit Required Documents

01

Final, official and certified high school transcript submitted as a hardcopy

02

Two recent identical passport size photographs (size 4 x 6 cm) with white background

03

Health Certificate issued inside Qatar

04

Official test score reports for applicants to Colleges that require Foundation Program (if available) to be submitted to the Foundation Program Testing Center in order to be exempted from the Foundation Program.

05

Photocopy of the applicant's Qatar ID card. And copy of the passport for non-Qataris. (Non-Qatari applicants must also provide a copy of their passport; international students please refer to International Students website)



Please submit the required documents to the following:

Student Affairs (I11) first floor, One Stop Center, Sunday to Thursday, 8:00 AM -1:00 PM
Male Students, first floor hall number C204.
Female students, first floor hall number C250.

Notes about handing the high school transcript

- Students from Qatari government and independent schools graduated from 2016 onwards do not have to submit their high school transcript; QU will receive their results from the Ministry of Education and Higher Education.
- Students from private and international high schools, also students from Qatari government and independent schools graduated in 2015 and earlier, have to submit original, final, official, and certified high school transcript along with copies to check if it matches the original documents, and attend in person to Qatar University before the deadline.
- Applicants with Qatari parents must upload a copy of the applicant's parent Qatar ID card and a copy of the Birth certificate and non-Qatari female students married to Qatari nationals must also upload a copy of the marriage contract and a copy of the ID card of the husband (an electronic link will be sent to applicants to upload required documents for Qatari parents and Qatari husband)
- Standardized tests results should be submitted to the QU Testing Center before the deadline
- Regarding the British system and IB system, students have to submit the predicted results form for the 12th grades subjects.

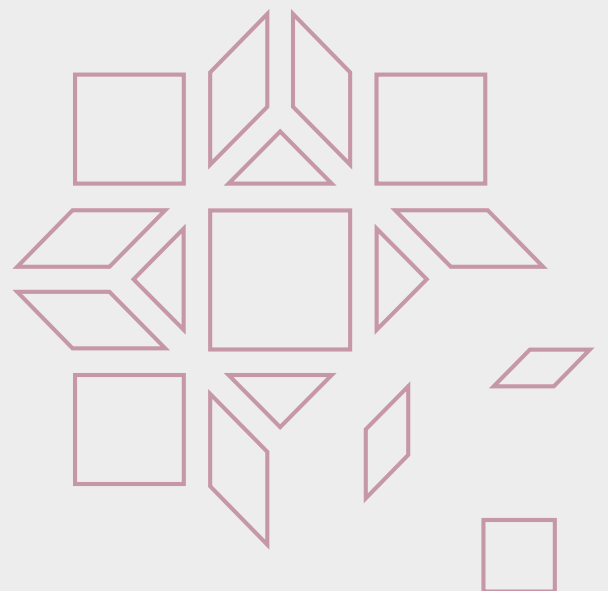
The predicted results form British system
